- •Parade groups with animals of any kind must provide people to perform immediate "pooper scooper" duties. This is to be fair to the groups following you.
- •The parade (line of march) is continuous, units do not stop in front of the reviewing stand, nor any other place to preform.

#### **Parade Entrance:**

All entries with vehicles and floats must enter the parade route on Cumberland Ave by Georgia Pacific.

•IMPORTANT: Please designate a "Group Leader" to represent your group and sign in at the registration tent near Wilcox Dock area. If you are walking to the parade area from the south please sign in at the information table near the former Elk's Lodge. It is important for us to know that you have arrived, especially since last-minute changes in the line-up are often necessary.
