Dear Friends of The Battle of Plattsburgh Commemoration,

I am writing to inform you about 1814 Commemoration Inc., a 501(c)3 nonprofit established in February 2020, dedicated to preserving history and the long tradition of commemorating the historic battles that took place in Plattsburgh and on Lake Champlain on September 11, 1814.

The first celebration took place soon after the battles and citizens in Plattsburgh have continued to commemorate this important history for two hundred and six years. In 1998, a group of citizens decided to organize a commemoration with the hope that it would become an annual event. Commemorations have continued for twenty-two years because of dedicated volunteers and generous support from businesses and individuals in our community.

In 2020, due to an extraordinary situation, it was impossible to have a traditional commemoration, however, volunteers worked with Carlin Media to create a website (1814inc .co m) and successfully presented a "Virtual Commemoration". In addition, Mountain Lake PBS and WCAX -TV aired documentaries, and WIRY Radio interviewed local Historians. Traditional Memorial Ceremonies were held at historic sites and the event ended with a themed drive-in concert.

Plans are currently underway for the return of a traditional Commemoration and we hope that you will consider becoming a sponsor. We invite you to partner with 1814 Commemoration Inc. and help us present the September 9th - 12th Battle of Plattsburgh Commemoration.
