

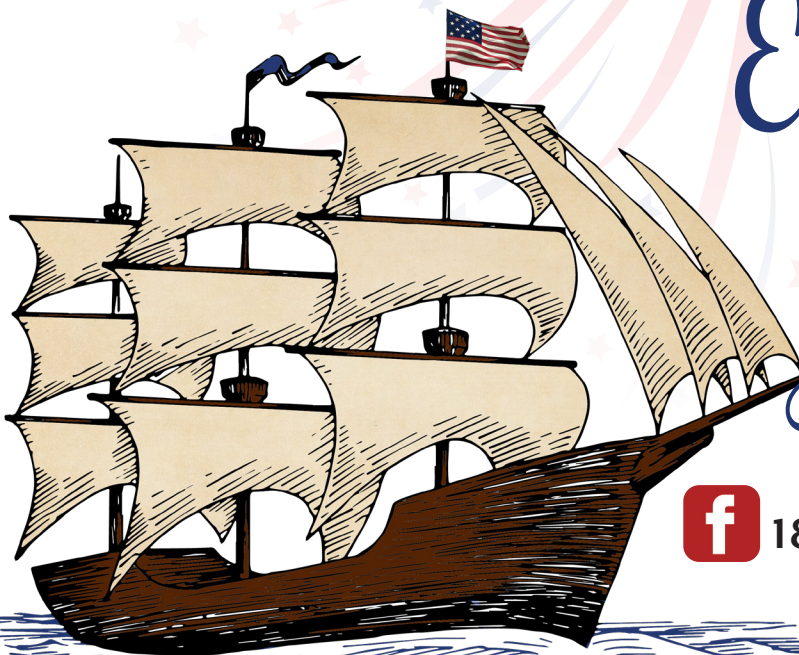

# An Invitation

## TO FRIENDS OF THE BATTLE OF PLATTSBURGH

**On September 23, 1814**, a letter signed by Henry Delord, Levi Platt, John Harford and William Swetland was sent to Commodore Thomas Macdonough stating the following:  
*“The Citizens of Plattsburgh are deeply impressed with the immense importance of the late brilliant naval victory achieved by you, and the naval force under your command, not only to the nation in general, but more particularly to this whole extent of country bordering on Lake Champlain.”*



The letter continued to praise the distinguished skill and bravery which led to an auspicious result and on behalf of the Citizens of Plattsburgh they invited Commodore Macdonough, General Alexander Macomb, General Benjamin Mooers and other officers of the army and navy to a public dinner at the United States Hotel, in Plattsburgh, to celebrate their victory.

Since that first celebration Citizens in Plattsburgh have continued to commemorate the importance of the historical military and civilian events, known as “The Battle of Plattsburgh.”

On behalf of the volunteers at 1814 Commemoration Inc., I am pleased to announce the 24th Annual Commemoration of the September 11, 1814, Battle of Plattsburgh. People in communities throughout our region, and beyond, are invited to experience “Living History,” September 9 – 11, in Plattsburgh, our host city. ## **The Battle of Plattsburgh Commemoration**

The American victory over the British on September 11, 1814, was celebrated by citizens in Plattsburgh within weeks after the battle and commemorations have continued for more than 200 years. In 1998 a small group of volunteers led by Christopher "Kit" Booth organized a commemorative event which has evolved into the annual Battle of Plattsburgh Commemoration that we enjoy today.

A Plattsburgh based 501(C)3 nonprofit, volunteer organization, dedicated to preserving the history of the Sept. 11, 1814, Battle of Plattsburgh by presenting an annual "Living History" Commemoration of this historical event.
